At the end of the Festival work may be collected from the Library on Sunday 21st May at 12-1. (Please nominate a friend to collect on your behalf if you are unable to attend yourself).

- All entries must be an original, not a copy or a print
- The work may be in any medium.
- No dimension may exceed 76cms (30 inches)
- Please label the back of the work with your name, address, title of work and medium.
- The work should be ready to hang with D rings (preferably) and strong cord.
- No work may be removed before the end of the Festival.
- The Festival Committee will not accept responsibility for loss or damage to entries.
- Please bring the slip below with you when you hand in your work.
